Junior Player Code of Conduct

This code is designed to:

Provide guidance for junior players involved in any activity sanctioned, staged by or held under the auspices of The Dunoon United Football Club including, but not exclusively, matches and training sessions.

Player Code

As a junior player I will:

- Always play to the best of my ability
- Play fairly – I won't cheat, complain or waste time
- Respect my team-mates, the other team, the referee, my coach and manager
- Play by the rules, as directed by the referee
- Shake hands with the other team and referee at the end of the game
- Listen and respond to what my coach and team manager tells me
- Talk to someone I trust or the club committee if I am unhappy about anything at my club

I understand that if I do not follow the Code any or all of the following actions may be taken by my club or competition administrator.

I may:

- Be required to apologise to my team-mates, the other team, the referee, my coach or manager
- Receive a formal warning from the coach or the club committee
- Be dropped or substituted
- Be suspended from training
- Be required to leave the club

In addition the club will inform my parent or carer of any infringement of the Code of Conduct.

As a registered junior play at DUFC you have agreed to abide by this code of conduct.
